

SDSU Student Learning Outcomes and Programmatic Assessment Committee

The SDSU SLOPAC is a senate-appointed committee with the following membership and functions as defined within the SDSU Policy File:

1.0 Membership (13): Nine faculty, one from each College, the University Library, and the SDSU-IV Campus; Associate Dean of Undergraduate Studies; Associate Vice President of Student Affairs; two students.

2.0 Functions

2.1 The Committee shall provide oversight for student learning outcomes and shall evaluate student learning assessment plans for all degrees and programs, including programs accredited by external agencies.

2.2 The Committee shall annually review reports on student learning outcomes from all degrees and programs

2.3 The Committee shall provide the Senate, and, when relevant, the Graduate Council, with an annual report regarding the progress of student learning outcomes assessment for all degrees and programs, and programs accredited by external agencies.
